DOG LICENSE INFORMATION

- **Who has to license their dog?**

All dogs over the age of 6 months, residing in the Town of Belchertown must be licensed.

- **When do I license my dog?**

Current licenses expire on December 31st. The Clerk's office begins issuing new licenses in November for the coming year. Reminders are included with the census. You may use the form on the census to license your dog as long as the Clerk's office has a current rabies vaccine certificate on file. If the rabies vaccination on file is not current, please include the updated certificate with your renewal along with the appropriate fee (below).

- **What do I need to bring with me to license my dog?**

Proof of up-to-date rabies vaccination from your veterinarian is required for a license to be issued.

- **What is the fee to license my dog?**

Spayed female and neutered male: \$8.00

Un-spayed females and un-neutered males: \$15.00

- **May I license my dog by mail?**

You may license your dog by mail by sending the appropriate fee (above) with a copy of the current rabies certificate from your veterinarian. The license will be sent back to you within 3 weeks.
